Abstract submission deadline has been extended to: Thursday January 5th 2023

Please read the following instructions carefully before submitting your work

All abstracts must be written and presented in English. Linguistic correctness is the responsibility of the authors.

Abstracts must not exceed 250 words, excluding title, names and affiliations. The maximum total number of keystrokes (characters, including spaces) is 2,250, including approximately 500 keystrokes for title, authors and affiliations. If the latter exceeds 500 keystrokes, the available keystrokes for the abstract text will be reduced accordingly.

Please do not include tables, figures, keywords, or references.

Abstracts must contain a clear statement of the purpose of the work, the methods used, the results, and conclusions. Results should be presented in sufficient detail to support the conclusions drawn. Reviewers will be advised to reject abstracts that do not contain objective data, since it is very difficult to evaluate the suitability of these abstracts for presentation. The decision on acceptance/rejection by the ICEL 9 editorial committee is final. Abstracts should contain original work that has not been published by the date of initial submission to ICEL9.

Selected reviewers with a high level of expertise in the relevant fields will decide whether abstracts are accepted (with amendments, if necessary) and, if accepted, whether they should be presented orally or as posters. They will also assign abstracts selected for oral presentation to the most appropriate sessions of the symposium.

If the editorial committee requests changes to, or clarifications regarding your abstract, you will be informed by e-mail no later than **February 20th, 2023**. Amended abstracts will be due by **March 20th, 2023**.

A final decision regarding acceptance of your abstract and form of presentation will be provided to you by email no later than **April 3rd, 2023**.

The presenting author should be indicated clearly. Be aware that if this presenting author does not register for the ICEL 9 conference by **May 5th, 2023**, their contribution will be removed from the programme and the compilation of abstracts for publication.
